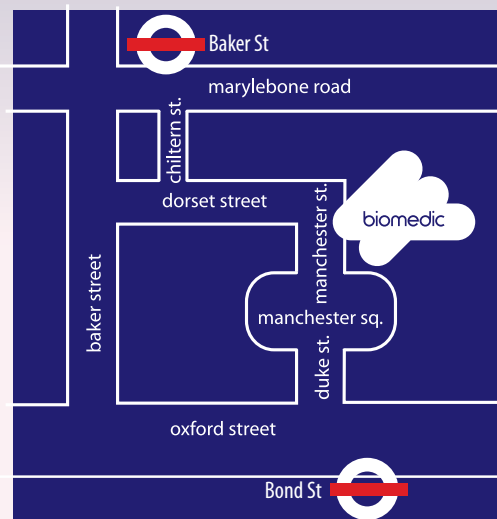

There is a metered parking in front of the Centre, and 24 hours open NCP garage in Chiltern Street.

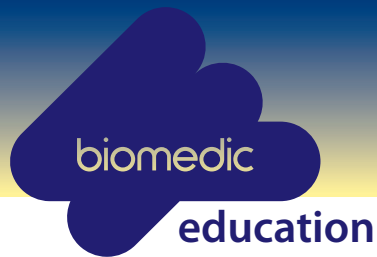

Postgraduate Course in Bioregulatory Medicine

Biomedic Foundation is a registered educational charity that runs the **Academy for Bioregulatory Medicine**. The academy teaches several diploma and certificate courses throughout an academic year. The courses are intended for practitioners and doctors seeking proficiency in integrative holistic Healthcare, which spans from allopathic to complementary and alternative medicine. All courses are held at the **Biomedic Centre**, which is a pioneering clinic for applied Bioregulation.

Bioregulatory Medicine

Bioregulatory Medicine is an interdisciplinary therapeutic approach that **restores homeostasis by biological medical methodologies**. It puts the healing power of Nature back into clinical practice, as stated by Hippocrates's principle - "Vis Medicatrix Naturae".

Bioregulatory Medicine was formulated in the early nineties by Dr Damir Shakambet and Dr Tatyana Bosh to integrate healing wisdom with contemporary medical sciences. It presents the teaching of Dr S. Hahnemann, Dr H. Reckeweg, Dr. M. Gerson and other medical pioneers, within the context of Molecular Biology, Physiology, Psychology, Quantum Physics and Biological Open Systems Theory.

Bioregulatory Medicine offers an opportunity to **improve Health** by restoration of informational flow, cellular regeneration and detoxification of the biological terrain.

Diploma Course

The Course in Bioregulatory Medicine is a registered **Postgraduate Diploma Course** that attracts **CPD points**.

The course consists of seven weekends, within the academic year, teaching the theory and practice of Bioregulatory Medicine. Participants are provided with comprehensive study manuals, while lectures are interspersed with visual aids and clinical hours. Lecturers and clinical supervisors are Medical Doctors with expertise in integrative Bioregulatory therapies.

The course integrates Allopathic, Homeopathic, Naturopathic, Psychosomatic and Traditional Chinese Medicine within a concept of **Bioregulation**, respecting both disease-centred and Health-centred points of view. It also enables participants to prescribe homeopathic nanopharmaceuticals, a valuable addition to any practitioner, as an alternative or complement to pharmaceutical drugs.

The course graduates are invited to become members and fellows of the Society for Bioregulatory Medicine, which is a fast growing network of like minded Healthcare practitioners. The Society provides an opportunity for continual professional research and development, as well as for clinical exchange and referral network.
